Water demand was double the YTD high but requests for water are much lower. There is potential for limited water in May & June but it is not a high likelihood. Napa San is going to undertake an audit of the user-supervisor list and report back next meeting. Chloride levels are slightly higher than normal due to a dry spring

b. Update on the schedule of and wastewater MSR

The plan was to release a draft to the public on April 6th but the meeting was cancelled. On the May 4th agenda they decided to release the report on May 18th to allow time for a distributed administrative draft. A public workshop will happen at the end of June/beginning of July but it has not been scheduled yet. The hope is to have it approved at the August 3rd meeting
