- 2. Public Comment. This is the time for the public to address the Board. No formal action can be taken by the Board on public comment items at the meeting, the Board can direct that an item be placed on a future agenda for discussion and possible action. There is a 5-minute per person limitation.
- 3. Approve Minutes of the Special Meeting of April 14, 2021.
- 4. Discussion and possible action on appointing one qualified Landowner to be a Director, to fill a vacancy created by the resignation of Samantha Mueller. On April 15, notifications were posted in three conspicuous places throughout the District, and at the District's website as well as emailed to District's list-serve. Applications were accepted by Legal Counsel, the Application period ran from April 15th to May 7th, 2021. At this meeting, interviews of qualified applicants will be conducted, and it is anticipated an appointment will be made. Any newly appointed member will be filling a term which expires in December 2022, and therefore will be required to stand for election at the next regular District election in November 2022.

- 6. Discussion of Third Quarter Financial Report ending March 31, 2021 by Auditor-Controller Tracy Schulze.
- 7. Discussion and possible action on approving a contract for financial audit services from Charles W. Pillon, CPA, for the years ending June 30, 2020 and 2021.
- 8. Public Hearing: Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2021-22
 - a. Open Public Hearing.
 - b. Review Proposed Budget Auditor-Controller will present the draft of the proposed budget for fiscal year 2021-22. The budget includes two divisions as follows:
 - Operations General district operations including accounting, legal and engineering costs for the assessment administration, offset by \$20,000 annual allocation in assessment revenues; and
 - Debt Service Annual debt principal and interest payment on the State Water Resources Control Board Revolving Loan, originally secured for the construction of the Recycled Pipeline.

 - e. Board Discussion- Receive Board input on line items and amounts.
 - f. Tentatively approve the fiscal year 2021-22 draft budget.
 - g. Set June 8, 2021 as the time and place for the public hearing on the adoption of the final budget.

 - a. The District has a new, ADA compliant website still found at: www.carneroswater.org.
 - b. The old website has been shut down.
 - c. Content on the new site dates back to the beginning of 2020.

 - e. The annual hosting fee with the new website host is \$600.
 - f. The annual domain registration for the site will be \$120.
- 10. Discussion and possible action on adoption of a Resolution and District Records Retention Policy. Pursuant to Section 60200 et seq. of the Government Code of the State of California, record retention schedules are used by public entities across the State of California and are an appropriate mechanism for the Board to proactively make the determination when various categories of records will no longer be necessary or required for District purposes. Under Section 60201, the Board may authorize the destruction of records prepared or received pursuant to State or federal statute where those records have been maintained for the required period of time and the Board has determined retention of those records is no longer necessary or required for District purposes.
